

'LOCKOUTS'

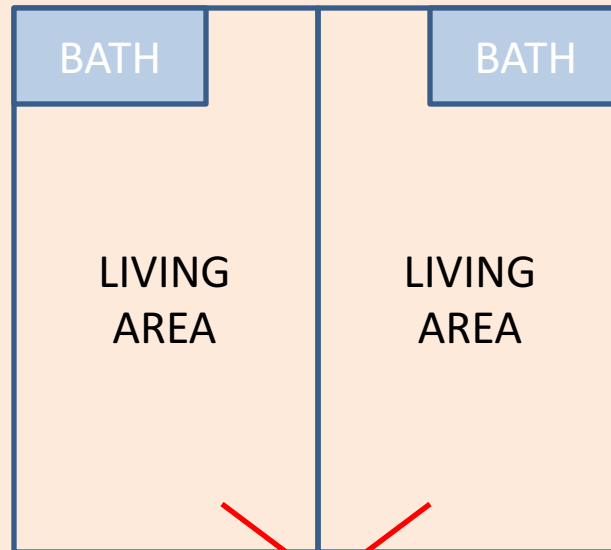
An undefined term which has come to mean separately rented bedrooms in a residence.

TWO TRANSIENT ROGOs

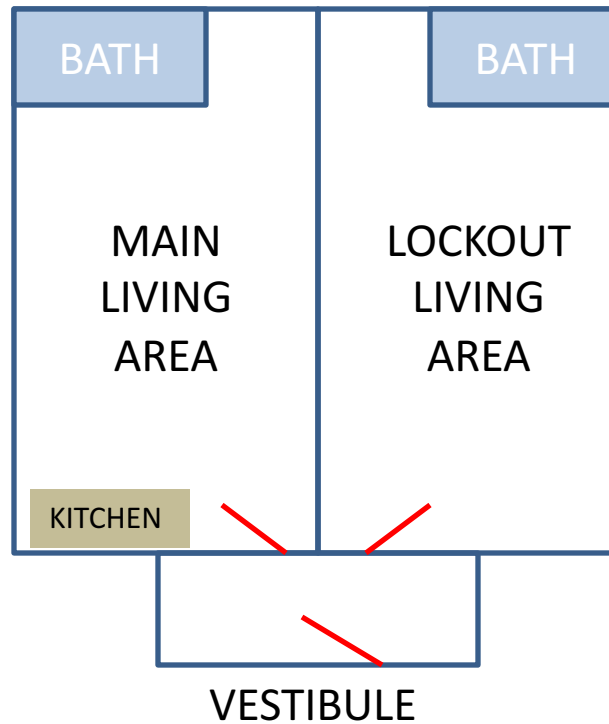
Two traditional hotel or motel rooms

Uses one lockable entrance into a vestibule.

The vestibule has entrances into multiple bedrooms each with its own lockable door.

Each bedroom can have a full bathroom.

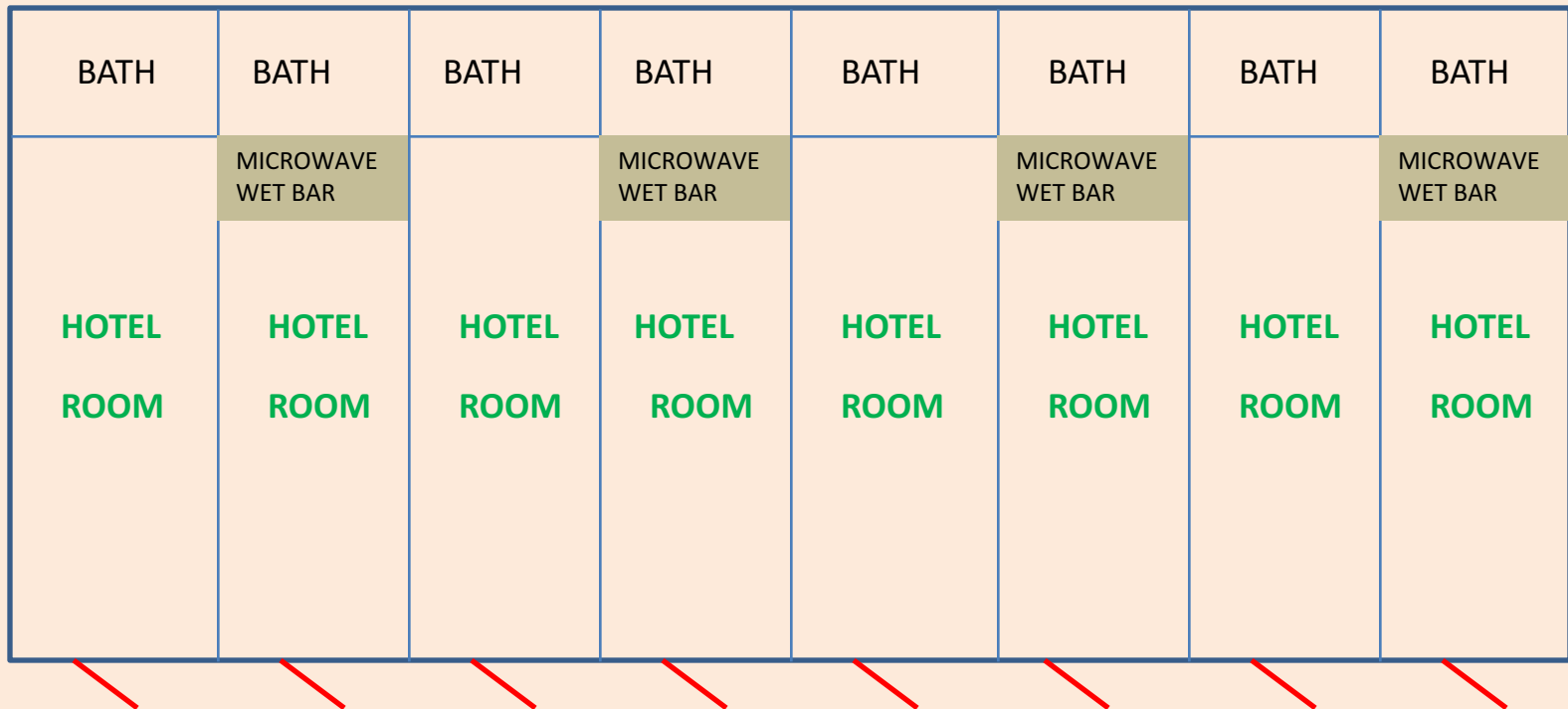
Each bedroom can be separately rented to different families or guests.
